from the manufacturer Thrane & Thrane A/S (TT). The equipment is intended to be used aboard vessels. TT has used tests according to the ETSI standard EN 301 444 to demonstrate presumption of compliance with the essential requirements of Directive 1999/5/EC for the above mentioned equipment.

EN 301 444 is only intended to be used for land based equipment. It is the assessment of NITA that the test suites in EN 301 444 are applicable also for equipment to be used aboard vessels. This assessment is made according to Annex 7 in Executive Order No 27 of 10<sup>th</sup> January 2007 on Radio and Telecommunications Terminal Equipment and Electro-magnetic Matters. Fulfilment of the test suites gives presumption of compliance with the essential requirements of Directive 1999/5/EC for the above mentioned equipment.

The radio equipment must only be marketed if duly marked i.e. bearing the CE marking. As the equipment makes use of frequencies which are harmonised throughout the EU according to Annex 3, par. 2 in the above mentioned Executive Order, the equipment shall not bear the alert marking, but a reference to the notified body, Identification Number 0170, shall form part of the marking.
